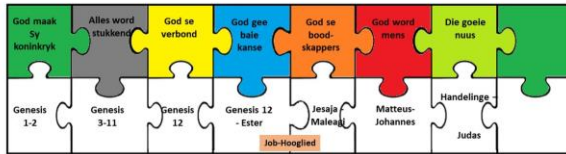


God se koninkryk: deel 7 – Die goeie nuus

Die verskillende dele van die hele storie

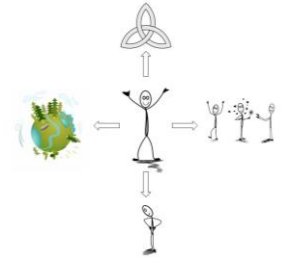

Wat kom doen die Heilige Gees?

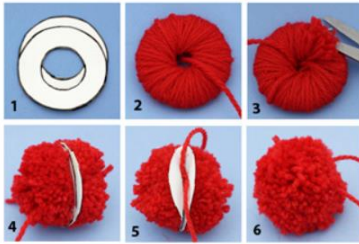
- Gee vir ons nuwe oë, nuwe ore, nuwe lewe (Joh 3:3-5, Rom 8:9)
- Gee ons die vermoë en gawes om die kerk te bou (1 Kor 12)
- Maak ons heilig (anders) - Gal 5:22



Maak 'n goeie nuus mannetjie: Maak 'n pom-pom, knip die arms, voete en Bybel uit en plak dit aan die pom-pom vas. Plak ogies op en knip die vers hieronder uit Jesaja uit en plak dit onder sy voete vas. Sy voete is so groot sodat hy ORAL kan loop en vertel!

Jesaja 52:4 - Hoe wonderlik klink op die berge die voetstaple van hom wat die goeie boodskap bring, wat vrede aankondig, wat die goeie tyding bring, wat redding aankondig, wat vir Sion sê: "Jou God is Koning!"

4. To make the pom pom maker cut two, three-inch circles out of poster board or other cardboard. Cut two-inch circles out of the centers of these two circles to form a donut shape.



5. Hold the two circles together and wrap yarn around the donut shape through the hole in the center starting at one point and filling in with yarn until the cardboard is covered. Keep wrapping the yarn until you come back to the same point you started. To make things go quicker, cut a long length of the yarn and roll it up into a small ball. Then start wrapping, pushing the ball through the hole instead of pulling the whole length of yarn through the hole each time. Don't worry about end pieces that stick out; you can cut them off later. To keep the yarn in place when you start a new color just wrap the new piece around the end of the old piece. Don't tie knots.

6. Keep wrapping the yarn until you can't get any more yarn to fit through the hole.

7. To finish cut the yarn loops all the way around the edge of the circle using sharp scissors. When you have cut all the loops you will see the edge of the cardboard circles. Use another piece of yarn to tie the pom-pom. Separate the two circles just enough to get the piece of yarn in between the two circles. Place the yarn all the way around the inside of the circle and pull tight and tie a knot. Pull off the cardboard circles or cut them away. Trim any pieces of yarn that are sticking out too far.
